Location

The Italian capital, Rome, boasts an unrivalled 3,000 year heritage of globally influential art, architecture and culture. The city is home to iconic historic landmarks, including the ancient ruins of the Colosseum and the Roman Forum, and abounds with world-class museums such as the Vatican Museums and Borghese Gallery. As well as substantial Roman remains, significant Baroque and Renaissance buildings pepper the city centre. Today, Rome is not only a cultural centre, but also a commercial, financial and education hub that has successfully retained its traditional culture and regional cuisine.

Conference Venue

The conference will take place at the Sapienza University of Rome. Founded in 1303 it is one of the oldest Universities in history. The University has its own museum network (Sapienza Museum Network) which is often open to a general audience. The Alessandrina University Library, built in 1667 by Pope Alexander VII, is the main library housing many important collections. The university has significant research programmes in the fields of engineering, natural sciences, biomedical sciences and humanities.
